If you have not already done so this season, you and your parent **MUST** sign **BOTH** the Expectation and Permission forms **ONLINE** before this meeting.

Remember to wear or bring a **PLAIN BLACK SHIRT** for your headshot if you did not already have one taken in the Fall/Winter of 2021.
