Character Descriptions

ULTIO- The only Aberrant who works for the ADA. Driven by revenge after the loss of his mother, he seeks to end all other Aberrants, with a special vengeance for the one who killed his mom. He is sharp, quick, and calculated, relying on the voice in his head to help him stay safe.

FORIAS- The older brother of Karma. Views himself as the lone protector for his little sister, he is strong but insecure. Repeated use of his ability has left physical and mental cuts on him, pushing himself to whatever means necessary to keep Karma safe.

KARMA- The younger sister of Forias. The voice of reason and Forias's tether, she is quiet and strong. Unable to feel any physical pain, she instead relies on the emotions of others, picking up on the feelings of those around her; she is Forias's only pillar of support.

MS. HARMONY- The head of the Aberrant Detainment Agency. With the possibility of a promotion, she has taken up the task of removing Aberrants from society. Playing a mother-like role to the people of the ADA, she uses her position to deceive others for her ultimate goal.

Adult Cast

MOTHER/LYNX- Ultio's mother and the voice of his trauma. Before her death, she was calm, collected, and kind. But after her death, she lives in her son's head, guiding and helping him in whatever fight he finds himself in. Was part of an experiment when she was young, causing her to stay on the ADA's radar after all these years.

DR. VOSS- Is responsible for the creation of Aberrants and the overseer of the ADA. After an experiment gone wrong, Voss shut down his program, only for problems to resurface years later. With the test subjects now grown and with families of their own, their kids possess strange abilities, being seen as a threat and a liability for Dr. Voss and his company.

FATHER- Forias and Karma's father. A violent man prone to lashing out, after taking part in an experiment in his youth, his children now possess hidden abilities. Years of his mistreatment cause Forias and Karma to run away after his passing, relying on each other to get by.
